Background

Tutor.com is an online service that provides live homework help in math, science, social studies and English to students in grades 4-12. This service is available 35 hours per week from 2 pm-1 am. Students interact online with certified subject experts, either from the library or remotely. There is also help available in Spanish in math and science Sunday-Thursday. Libraries receive detailed monthly usage reports, introductory marketing materials and 24/7 customer support. Currently the pricing structure is \$.21 per capita for the library's chartered service population, with a 10% discount which would increase as more libraries join.
