Online donations in the U.S. are up 58% since 2003. MHLS staff has been investigating a number of options that would allow any library to incorporate online giving opportunities to their web site.

Volunteer Opportunities	<input type="checkbox"/> Volunteer Opportunities	This option allows you to describe your volunteer program, what volunteer jobs are available and a volunteer application. Sample wording for this area is available.
Friends Group	<input type="checkbox"/> Friends Group Information	Describe your Friends Group and let someone know how they can become involved either as a donor or a volunteer. Sample wording for this area is available.
Affiliations	<input type="checkbox"/> The Library Shop <input type="checkbox"/> Shop for the Library <input type="checkbox"/> Amazon.com	<p>This is a “kick-back” program through the New York Public Library’s Library Links Program. Your library receives a 15% commission on sales generated through a link on your web site.</p> <p>Shop for the Library offers a virtual shopping mall, by becoming an affiliate a library receives a percentage of all sales resulting when customers are referred from the Shop web site.</p> <p>If you become an Amazon Associates we would add a button on your site to drive traffic to Amazon.com.
